



NOTICE OF RACE

2010 Canadian National Championship Regatta for the Soling One Meter class & 2010 Regional Championship Regatta for Soling One Meter Class for AMYA Region 1 Toronto, Ontario, July 2 – 4, 2010

- Venue:** Regatta will be hosted by the Metro Marine Modellers of Toronto's sail division, at Humber Park East sailing pond.
- Date:** Regatta will be held from July 2 to 4, 2010.
- Eligibility:** Skippers of Soling 1 Meter Class boats registered with either the Canadian Radio Yachting Association (CRYA) or the American Model Yachting Association (AMYA) who are good standing with their respective National Authority may participate. Eligible boats may enter by completing the attached form, and sending it, complete with the required fee, to the organizers listed below, before June 12, 2010.
- Number of Entries:** The following restrictions on the number of boats apply: A maximum of forty eight (48) boats racing in a three (3) heat promotion/relegation system will be entered in the regatta. Entries will be accepted on a first come, first served basis. Entries must be received before June 12, 2010. Entries received after June 12 may be accepted at the Race Director's discretion.
- Entry Fee:** Canadian \$55.00 (Includes Gift Bag, Lunch on Saturday and Sunday and Saturday afternoon Social) cheque or money order mailed in , see below for address.
- Rules:** The regatta will be governed by the 2009-2012 Racing Rules of Sailing, including Appendix E, the rules of the Soling 1 Meter Class, this Notice of Race, the Sailing Instructions and any amendments to the Sailing Instructions made by the Race Director prior to commencement to any race.
- Frequencies:** The Entry Form **must** indicate at least three (3) available frequencies (or indicate 2.4 GHz) for each boat entered.
- Measurement:** Measurement will be conducted at the time of registration and may be conducted thereafter on any or all boats without notice throughout the regatta, as determined by the Race Director, acting in his or her sole discretion. The 1st, 2nd and 3rd place overall boats must be presented to the RD station for

measurement immediately after completing their last heats, prior to any awards presentation.

Measurement may include any class requirement and without limitation may include:

- Production of the boat's Class Association Registration
- entrant's current AMYA or CRYA Membership card.
- Verification that sail markings meet class and RRS rules (note all Canadian boats entered must comply with Appendix E6 of the RRS by prescription of the Canadian Yachting Association)
- that the following conform to class rules:
 - sail material; sail thickness; sail dimensions; battens; boat weight, hull length, rudder and keel thickness, size and shape; mast height; mainsail and jib height; jib swivel position; hull shapes as evidenced by the presence of the kit bulkheads installed in their designated positions with their flanges and webs substantially intact.

AMYA/CRYA Soling 1 Meter skipper rankings.

The AMYA and CRYA are contemplating compiling Soling 1 Meter skipper rankings for their respective class member's, in a manner similar to those used by the IOM and Victoria classes. It is possible that the results of this Regatta will be counted. Those interested in achieving high rankings within the class should therefore consider entering this event. More information on rankings will be published on the Yahoo.com Soling 1 meter user group, Soling1meter.org website and in the CRYA and AMYA newsletters, as the ranking project progresses.

Schedule of Events:

- **Ten races are required to constitute the regatta.**
- **Friday July 2nd:**
 - 2:00pm – 6:00pm. Registration, measurement and inspection, and practice sailing onsite at Humber Park
- **Saturday 3rd:**
 - 8:00am – 9:00am. Registration.
 - 9:30am. Skippers meeting.
 - Start of first race immediately follows skipper's meeting.
 - 12:00pm – 12:30pm Lunch. (If conditions permit, there will be a break from racing, otherwise it will be ('eat with your heat')
 - No race shall start after 4:30pm or earlier at the discretion of the Race Director
 - 5:30pm. Social Snack.
- **Sunday 4th:**
 - 9:00am Skipper's meeting.
 - Start of first race immediately follows skipper's meeting. No race shall start after 1:30pm.
 - 12:00 – 1:00pm Lunch. (**no** break for lunch, eat with your heat).
 - 2:00pm. Awards presentation and closing.

Regatta Site & Description:

The Regatta will be held at Humber Bay Park East, located on Humber Bay Park Road East, off of Marine Parade Dr. The nearest major intersection is Park Lawn/Gardner Express Way. Exit the Gardner Expressway at Park Lawn and go south on Park Lawn. Park Lawn is

renamed Marine Parade Drive south of Lakeshore Boulevard, so continue south across Lakeshore Boulevard. Humber Bay Park Road East is the first right turn off of Marine Parade Drive south of Lakeshore Boulevard. Humber Bay Park Road East ends at the venue parking lot and has no other turnoffs. Be careful of cycling, roller blading, and pedestrian activity in the area, particularly when turning onto Humber Bay Park Road East. Enter “Humber Bay Park East, Toronto” in Google Maps for Directions

Our Race Director, Ray Davidson, and Scorer, Don Burton, share decades of experience successfully organizing, directing, and participating in major R/C sailing regattas.

- The Race Course shall include a windward leg on each lap.
- The Race Course shall include an upwind start.
- The Race Course is planned to be a windward-leeward course including an offset mark at the windward mark and a gate at the leeward marks, with a mid-course start/finish line.
- Control areas will be adjacent to the start/finish lines.

The City of Toronto operates a high volume water pump which keeps the pond substantially clear of weeds. Collisions with turtles happen occasionally. The City was very cooperative last year in clearing away foliage, with the effect of permitting stronger breezes to reach more of the pond. This has substantially reconfigured the pond wind patterns. Further changes in flora are anticipated this year, and our club’s annual water’s edge shrubbery cutback is likely to take place just before the regatta. These changes will help mitigate any home pond advantage.

There is ample metered parking very close to the control and launch areas. We will endeavour to get the City to let us reserve parking spaces for added assurance.

Please note that July 1 is Canada Day and July 4 is U.S. Independence Day, and border crossing times and accommodation availability will be adversely affected as each country’s residents flee to the other country for the occasion. U.S. citizens are reminded that passports are required for them to re-enter the U.S., if they are inclined to do so. Penalties for the possession of unauthorized firearms, speed trap detectors and the use of hand held communication or entertainment devices while driving (e.g. cell phone, GPS, iPod’s and Mp3) in Ontario may be severe.

Awards: Trophies will be awarded to 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place finishers in the Regatta.
